# Goal: review status, assess readiness and outline needed progress of MC tools for the LHC

- 
- **accuracy**: NLO, multijets, decays, PDFs, EW corrections, jet quenching, etc etc
- **completeness**: backgrounds and signals, SM & BSM
- **reliability**: cross-comparisons
- **realism**: merging with shower/hadronization MC's
- **validation**: comparison and tuning against existing and LHC data
- **usability**: compliance with LHC software infrastructure requirements (C++, interfaces, MC datasets repositories)
