

Training

Each person joining the EGEE project receives basic courses on:

- a) Grid components in general and those specific to EGEE;
- b) The EGEE project structure;
- c) The intended operational structure of EGEE (RC, ROC, CIC, OMC, OAG).

Where new project members are working in a resource center, the implementation details and operational environment of that site are explained, in a series of specialized courses. Particular attention is paid to covering the aspects of 24/7 service and the tools used to achieve this availability. On demand, a project member of the associated ROC is sent to the resource center to complement the site specific courses by the EGEE oriented ones.

End users of EGEE are made familiar with the tools available to them, both in a theoretic and a practical way. This includes the explanation of basic terminology (UI, JDL, RB, RLS etc.) and how requests to the help desk are handled. The practical aspect is covered by test job submission to the available grid (initially EGEE-0 = LCG2), and to the use of other available user commands. The usage of the application software of a particular VO is not covered. However, for those users of a VO who are to be software managers, the deployment and maintenance mechanisms available to them are described. All this is done in a tutorial of two to three days in duration.

All training will use the material provided by NA3, as far as possible and when appropriate.
