Requirements

- Evolution
 - Better understanding of scientists' needs.
 - Changes in stated needs.
 - Response to experience with implementation.
 - Discovery of tacit requirements.
- Sources
 - Already collected by you.
 - Availability/Deadlines...
- Questions:
 - What are the stages of the “lifecycle”?
 - How to prioritize requirements?
 - By need, by date, by ...?
 - How to enforce prioritization?

Requirements

- Questions (cont.):
 - What tools to manage requirements/use cases?
 - Dependencies
 - Conflicts
 - Use case/requirement links
 - Service/applicable requirements links
 - Who decides when a requirement is satisfied?
 - PTF for “functional” requirements?
 - Testing group(s) for performance requirements?
 - ...
 - How to enforce administrative/design requirements?
 - Open source license
 - Documentation
 - ...

Services

- Evolution
 - As implementations mature.
 - As services merge/split.
 - Response to experience.
- Sources
 - Architecture document.
- Questions:
 - How to specify service APIs?
 - Abstract form (e.g. UML)?
 - Concrete form (WSDL)?
 - What is a complete service definition?
 - Methods and types.
 - Exceptions.
 - Schema of exposed state.

Services

- Questions (cont.):

- Semantics

- Method flow/state information.
 - Via documentation?

- Compatibility with existing/emerging standards?

- e.g. WS-I, WS-..., WSRF, ...

- Required functionality?

- Versioned service APIs?
 - Ping functionality?
 - Internationalization?

- Tools for tracking/versioning changes?

External Collaboration

- Other Grid Projects

- National projects.
 - EU projects.

- Client projects
 - Provider projects

- Global Projects

- Standards Bodies

- OASIS (WS)
 - GGF
 - IETF
