

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


# Our goal: it's all about policy enforcement



# Authentication “service”

- EU GridPMA
  - CA trust fabric
- Credential storage
  - MyProxy
- Closely monitoring current events
  - SSH based hacking
  - DOE reqs on OTP



# Authorization “service”

- Security architecture: keep decisions local
  - Authorization framework
- Convenience services to resolve management, distribution and scalability issues
  - VOMS

# Audit “service”

- No acceptable solution today
- Currently: Developer guidelines on consistent logging
  - Actual tracing will be manual and distributed
- Biomed coming in with additional requirements

# Key management for data confidentiality

- JRA3/NA4 (Biomed) collaboration
- Complete solution is a *HUGE* undertaking
  - Investigating what we can actually do
  - “Warm and fuzzy” solutions may be enough
