Why Europe?

- Strong researcher-researcher, institutional links.
- Australia the first 3rd country to establish an STC Agreement with the EU
- EU Lisbon Strategy has similar goals to NZ GIF
- Europe does close to 50% of the world's non-military R&D
- FP6 funds of €19 billion (NZ\$ 37 billion)
- Access to ideas, technology, facilities and people



Implementing the Strategy

The MoRST International Links Strategy gives top priority to EU, Germany, UK, France

Objectives:

- Engagement with European researchers including through FP6 and via institutional links
- Strengthen policy links
- Position NZ/Australia as reliable and beneficial partners for European research
