- **Collaboration Board (CB)**
 - Decides on main technical directions
 - Reps of all institution or Federation in the collaboration
- **Overview Board (POB)**
 - Oversees the functioning of the collaboration
 - Reps of the funding agencies
- **Management Board (MB)**
 - Supervises the work of the Project
 - Reps of Tier-0 and Tier-1's
- **Grid Deployment Board (GDB)**
 - discuss, take or prepare decisions for planning, deploying and operation
 - Reps from experiments and sites
- **Architects Forum (AF)**
 - Manages the work of the application areas (AA)
 - Leaders of the AA software projects
- **Experiment Related Task Forces**
 - Coordinated the usage by the experiments of software and services
 - Each task force is ran by an experiment



Mode of operation



- **Collaboration Board (CB)**
 - Meets annually or when need arises
- **Overview Board (POB)**
 - Four times per year
- **Management Board (MB)**
 - Weekly phone meetings (for 1 hour) on Tuesdays at 16:00 hrs.
 - Monthly (for 2 hours) 'face-to-face' meeting on Tuesday before the GDB
 - At the location where the GDB takes place
- **Grid Deployment Board (GDB)**
 - Meets monthly for a full day
 - Optionally precede by a technical pre-GDB meeting when need arises
- **Architects Forum (AF)**
 - Meets every 2 weeks
- **Experiment Related Task Forces**
 - Defined by the task forces

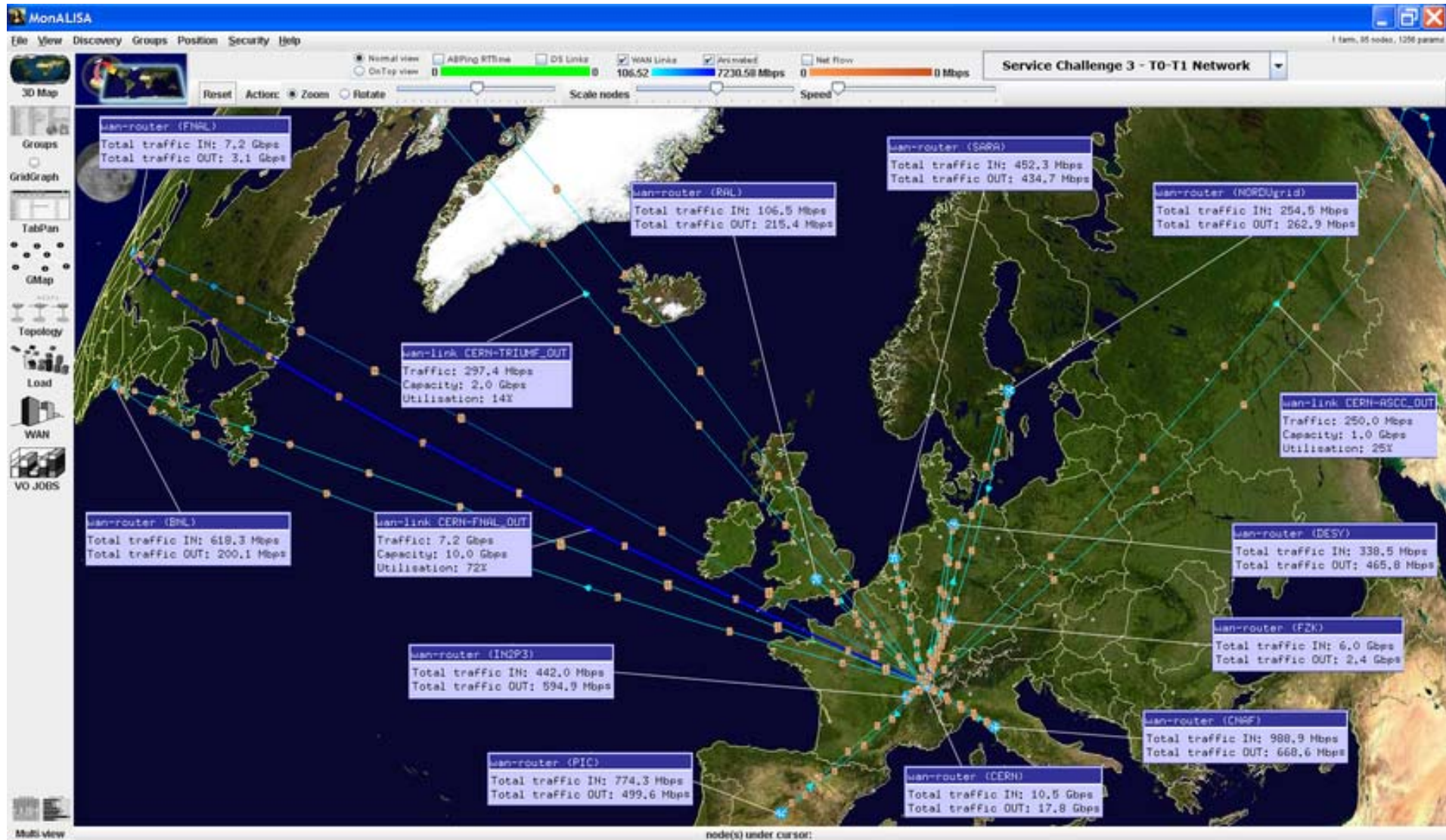
