Status of CR of kickoff meeting : COD0

- Action#1: Philippa Strange is joining Steve Traylen for the CIC-on-duty shifts. Ru will join us early April
- Action#2: O K did take care of that one.
- Action#3 : PN gives a status of reunification of all tests run in the federation, from GOC, from GridICe, from Cern and from France. All these are to be structured with the newly released version of RGMA, still under testing within SA1 testing team Markus' team.
- Action #5: The meeting between Savannah and GGUS turned short because of major incompatibility technically as well as availability speaking.
- Action #6: Next meeting will take place during Athens third Egee Conference COD2 . COD3 is supposed to take place in between 3rd and 4th Egee Conference within one of CIC's federation - Action taken by AM.
- ► <u>GGUS presentation W.T., H.D</u>
 - WT presents the concept of GGUS and the interface with ROCs' User Support system. He shows the workflow for a user. A special application for CIC assignment tickets will be deployed by GGUS.

Actual status: the ROC interface is on the way, new version of GGUS will be ready by Feb. 05, CIC requirements are underway by PN, DB, GM and will be discussed by ESC - EGEE Support Committee- whose kick-off meeting is held on $27^{th}/28^{th}$ Jan. in Karlsruhe.

- HD shows a live demo of the new version of GGUS (user and support staff interfaces, FAQ) and explains all the new features. WT gives an overview of future plans; planning will be done last week of January.
- Discussion on GGUS: the discussion was on the CIC requirements. This will be discussed in more details by WT, DB, GM, PN at FZK during ESC meeting
- *PN* & FS show Site Functional Tests Reports, Wiki FAQ, all the tools and the procedures used by CIC-on-duty staff, for GGUS to take into account relevant CIC requirements.

GridIce presentation – S.F.

- SF makes a presentation of GridIce on how and what is monitored. Since LCG_2_3_0, GridIce is part of the middleware distribution. A live demo shows the GridIce web interface. The web interface is under reorganization.
- SF asks for CIC's feedback.
- Sites Names Uniformisation PS
 - Underway PN & MT
- ➢ <u>CIC website</u> GM
 - GM shows the CIC web portal, and presents its new features. PS ask for a new presentation of CIC-on-duty tasks: she says it is confusing for new CIC-onduty people. AK wants the 'All in one tool' to be redefined.



TestZone tests, RGMA - PN

• PN shows the basics of RGMA for the monitoring. New release will be ready maybe for LCG_2_4_0. A GOC UI is still under development and PN shows some screen shots: it gives a better view of sites' status and ensures the modularity of testZone tests. RGMA schema differs from GridIce one: PN and SF will discuss on that, and how to integrate GridIce information.
