Dear all,

as Dominique stated, we could add 2 milestones for T1-Tx transfers:

1) Demonstration of stable usage of a 1 Gbps trans-atlantic link between CC-IN2P3 Tier-1 the Fermilab Tier-1 for transfering LHC data. This first phase should be achieved by 3rd quarter 2006 and then upgrade to a 10 Gpbs link during 2007.

2) Demonstration of stable usage of disk to disk transfer between CC-IN2P3 Tier-1 and Tier-2 in Japan. This should be done by 4th quarter 2006. The expected bandwidth would be around 1 Gbps in 2007.

Please note that the dates of these two goals will be more precisely defined in the coming weeks, when the partners taking part in these two projects meet together and establish a more detailed schedule.

In addition, we plan to participate to SC4-4 with CC-IN2P3 Tier-1 at least one french Tier-2.
