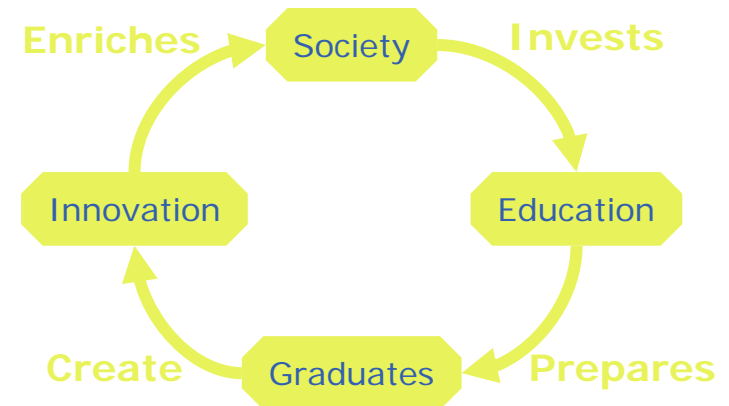
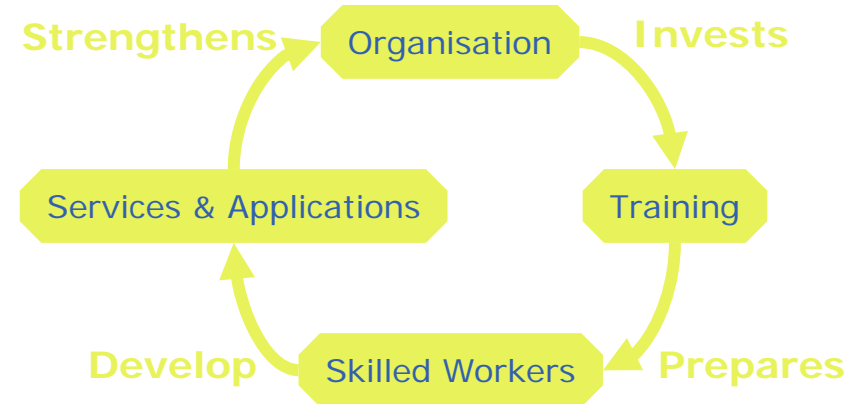
What are trainers and this event for?
