The Application Hosting Environment

- Based on the idea of applications as web services
- Lightweight hosting environment for running unmodified applications on grid resources (e.g. NGS, TeraGrid, DEISA) and on local resources
- Community model: expert user installs and configures an application and uses the AHE to share it with others
- Simple clients with very limited dependencies
- No intrusion onto target grid resources

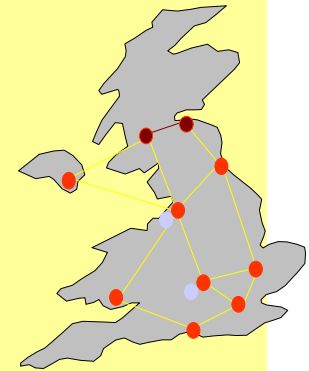
