Partner & Activity Metrics

- Events Database now has feedback from 48% of events held since start of EGEE-II (up from ~ 20%)
- On course to meet target of 1500 participant-days
- Some partners have still to run their first training event
 - Denmark, Portugal, Turkey
- Most active partners (participant-days/joint events):
 - FZK, MTA-SZTAKI, INFN, GRNET, PNPI/IHEP, UEDIN
- Some partners have heavily under- or over-reported effort
 - FZK 10%, ICI 185%

Digital Library - New features

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- Improved searching and sorting functionality
- Help system ("how to" articles)
- Web-content authoring service (> HTML files)
- Federated content support
- User authentication now recognises all 62 CAs accredited by EUGridPMA
- More multi-lingual content (Russian, French, Greek, Bulgarian)

Digital Library – future activity

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- FZK will contribute content breaking down modules to smaller components to imrpove granularity of training resources
- Image-file hosting for NA2 users
- Continued refinement of usage statistics
- Preparing further SMIL course modules for demo at OGF20, Manchester



Training at OGF20/User Forum

Two one-day courses to be run after **User Forum:**

- gLite Application Developers course, joint EGEE/OMII-Europe event
- **Future infrastructure for Grid** applications, joint EGEE/ETICS/OMII-Europe event

- Approached ITF and Insight Research Corporation
- Now have proposal from Qi3 Ltd:
 - 28 consultant-days
 - 10-week turn-round
 - Draft questionnaire prepared



Feedback on questionnaire

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- Oracle/Platform are vendors, not middleware providers
- Statement that "gLite is the next generation middleware for Grid computing" might annoy some people with long experience in Grids but no involvement in EGEE - opens us to ridicule
- Recent City#Grid conference in London didn't mention EGEE (or any EU project) once
- Message should not be "come and join us", but "how can we help you?"



Follow-on training survey

- Database constructed of past training attendees
- > 540 individuals have attended one or more courses
- Questionnaire currently being drafted
- Will also identify trainees who go on to be trainers



ETF and UIG

 ETF: peer- reviewing and repurposing existing training materials (mainly presentations and tutorials) for online delivery

 UIG: performing an editorial and commissioning function in order to ensure provision of essential user information, certified as up to date. Providing a "one stop shop" for documentation on commonly-used processes in EGEE.



Editorial Task Force

- Phase 1 (completed September 2006)
 - Set up ETF wiki and web-pages, commenting initially on induction-level courses
- Phase 2 (completion end January 2007)
 - Establish exemplars for Induction, Sys Admin, Installation,
 Training Trainers
 - Start on Application Developer courses
- Phase 3 (future)
 - All trainers to submit updated modules to improve exemplars and increase App. Dev. material

Wish-list for Application Developer Courses

- Harvest material from VO-developed applications to enhance training for other VOs:
 - Building-blocks
 - Scripts
 - Ways to use gLite services
- Identify EGEE-accredited higher level services/tools (not gLite) considered appropriate for inclusion in training
- For advanced courses, need to be able to submit complex jobs using WMProxy – any timescale for this?

- Partner (in)activity improving but needs chasing some more
- Design of questionnaire for commercial grid training survey
- Functionality concerns affecting training courses:
 - gLite-job-submit
 - WMProxy
- Difficult to devise new <u>interesting</u> course material aimed at new user communities
